COMMUNITY ADVISORY TEAMS PURPOSE




- Encourage two-way information sharing between the project and communities and engage in open dialogue with project leaders.

- Engage with our staff for project information as frequently as needed outside of team meetings.




PROJECT ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE


LYTTONSVILLE STATION RENDERING





LYTTONSVILLE STATION PLAN






TYPICAL SIDE PLATFORM RENDERING

PROJECT ACCOMPLISHMENTS



- Work progressed on five bridges, including light rail and Capital Crescent Trail (CCT) crossing of Connecticut Avenue.
- Opened the reconfigured bus loop at the College Park-UMD station.
- Began construction of four stations: Glenridge, Riverdale Park North-UMD, Silver Spring Library and Silver Spring.
- Opened the Sleaford underpass in Chevy Chase.
- Completed production of 26 of 28 light rail vehicles.






Lyttonsville Bridge Area

Recent and Ongoing Work:

- Began installation of Overhead Catenary System (OCS) foundations.
- Began wall construction.
- Began storm drain installation.

Upcoming Work:

- Complete roadway resurfacing on Lyttonsville Place Bridge.
- Begin station construction.





Talbot Avenue Bridge Area

Recent and Ongoing Work:

- Excavation and wall construction along 4th Avenue and Talbot Avenue.
- Installation of storm drain system.
- Installation of formwork to prepare for bridge deck pour.





Talbot Avenue Bridge

Upcoming Work:

- Begin wall work for the approach to the bridge behind Rosemary Hills Elementary School.
- Pour concrete bridge deck.
- Begin approach and roadway reconstruction on Talbot Avenue and 4th Avenue.





Woodside Area

Recent and Ongoing Work:

- Relocate sewer and water lines along the future site of the Capital Crescent Trail (CCT) between CSX tracks and 3rd Avenue.
- Completed jack and bore operations near CSX and Metro tracks and the Spring Street Bridge.

Upcoming Work:

- Begin wall construction along 16th Street.
- Begin crash wall installation along tracks.
- Install storm drain.





Bradford Place

Recent and Ongoing Work:

 Reconstructed one of three residential parking lots.

Upcoming Work:

 Establish access to begin wall construction near CSX tracks heading east to Colesville Road.



BUSINESS & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT



- Provide briefings for community and business groups.
- Manage stakeholder hotline (email/phone).
- Meet regularly with impacted businesses.
- Produce project newsletter and social media.
- Distribute construction notifications.
- Host Community Advisory Team (CAT) meetings.



MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC – WHAT TO EXPECT



- Existing traffic patterns will change as work occurs, as needed.
- Work may occur on both sides of the road and across roadways.
- When a lane closure is required, a notice will be distributed via text and email.
- Orange cones and barrels (temporary barricades) will be in place.
- Flag-person, when required, will direct traffic.
- Underground utility work may require temporary road plates.
