



Construction Notice

Overnight and Weekend Closures of Colesville Road

When: Beginning on or about January 5, 2020

Where: Colesville Road between East-West Highway and Wayne Avenue

On or about January 5, 2020 Colesville Road will be closed periodically between Wayne Avenue and East-West Highway as needed between the hours of 10 p.m. – 5 a.m. Monday – Friday through the end of April 2020. In addition to the evening closures, weekend closures will occur on an as needed basis beginning at 10 p.m. Friday – 5 a.m. on Monday through the end of April 2020. From 5 a.m. – 10 p.m. Colesville Road will have two lanes open in each direction with a Purple Line work zone in the center lane between East-West Highway and Wayne Avenue.

The closures are necessary to keep impacts to the area to a minimum to safely construct the two bridges that will carry the Capital Crescent Trail and Purple Line over Colesville Road. Please allow extra time to travel through the work zones for the safety of the public as well as the Purple Line workers on site.

The signed detour detailed below will be in place when Colesville Road is closed.

Traveling south on Colesville Road toward Georgia Avenue:

- Turn left onto Georgia Avenue
- Turn right onto East-West Highway
- Turn left onto Colesville Road

Traveling north on Colesville Road toward East-West Highway:

- Turn left onto East-West Highway
- Turn right onto 16th Street
- Turn right onto Georgia Avenue
- Turn left onto Spring Street
- Turn left onto Colesville Road

Starting January 5, 2020, MetroBus and RideOn stops on the first floor of the SSTC will be temporarily relocated to safely accommodate Purple Line work. The northbound right lane on Colesville Road between Wayne and Georgia Avenue will be repurposed for bus stops. Please visit the respective bus operator's website for more information on the location of the temporary stops.
