PURPLE LINE ANNOUNCES OCTOBER AND NOVEMBER COMMUNITY ADVISORY TEAM MEETINGS

Meetings Provide Updates for Neighborhoods on Construction

RIVERDALE, MD (September 14, 2023) – The Maryland Department of Transportation Maryland Transit Administration today announced the next round of Purple Line Community Advisory Team (CAT) meetings will be held in October and November. The meetings include member-driven teams of representatives appointed by neighborhood, civic and business associations and local governments. The virtual meetings will provide updates on construction activities at the neighborhood level.

“We’re looking forward to providing Purple Line updates to neighbors, businesses, community groups and elected officials at our upcoming fall Community Advisory Team meetings,” said Purple Line Project Director Ray Biggs II. “CAT meetings give us an opportunity for a more focused report on construction and the chance to engage with people in the communities most affected and interested in the project.”

The Purple Line project team, including representatives from Purple Line Transit Partners and Maryland Transit Solutions, will present project accomplishments, construction updates, station information and answer questions.

The virtual meetings will be held via Microsoft Teams Live, which offers captioning services in a variety of languages. Instructions on how to enable live captioning are posted on the project website, purplelinemd.com.
